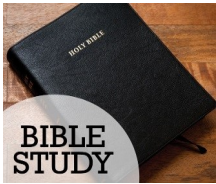

WOODWARD DREAM CRUISE 2018

The World's Biggest Cruise!

Did you know that the Woodward Dream Cruise actually started as a small fundraiser to raise money for a soccer field in Ferndale, Michigan?

In August 1995, Nelson House and a group of volunteers looked to relive and recreate the nostalgic heydays of the 50s and 60s, when youth, music and Motor City steel roamed Woodward Avenue, America's first highway. That year, 250,000 people participated—nearly ten times the number expected. The rest, as they say, is history.

Today, the Woodward Dream Cruise is the world's largest one-day automotive event, drawing 1.5 million people and 40,000 classic cars each year from around the globe—from as far away as New Zealand, Australia, Japan and the former Soviet Union. North American cruisers from California, Georgia,

Canada and all points in between caravan to Metro Detroit to participate in what has become, for many, an annual rite of summer.

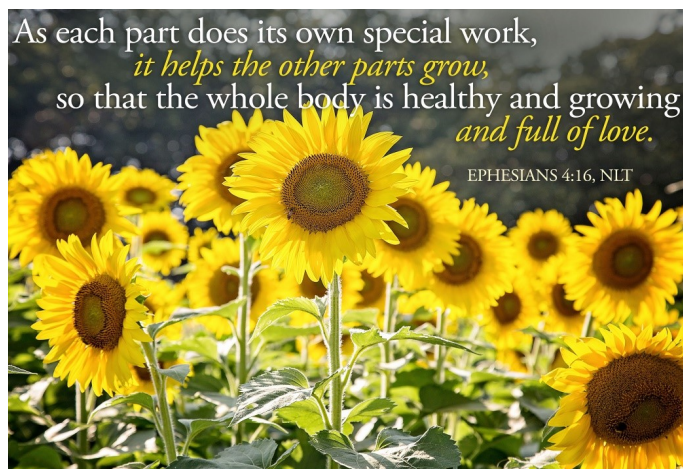
MAKE SLEEP A PRIORITY

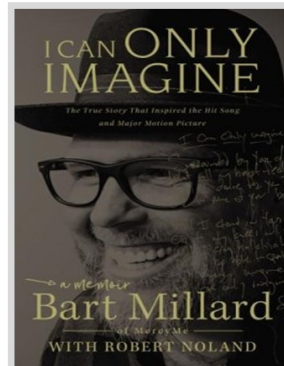
Forget the adage, “You snooze, you lose.” If you want to fire metabolism, sleep is your best ally. For one thing, growth hormone, which helps your metabolism function efficiently, is released when you sleep. For another, getting adequate shut-eye (most adults need seven to nine hours per night) helps keep the hormones that regulate appetite and satiety in the proper balance. What’s more, “if you get enough sleep, you’ll have enough energy to exercise, which will further boost your metabolism,” Dr. Katz notes, “These tweaks really do support one another.”
