Common House Plants Improve Indoor Air

Ordinary house plants can significantly reduce air pollution in homes and offices, according to research led by the University of Birmingham. In some cases, plants reduced the common pollutant nitrogen dioxide by as much as 20 percent. Researchers tested three houseplants – Peace lily, corn plant and fern arum. When placed in a chamber containing the amount of nitrogen dioxide comparable to an office located by a busy road, all the plants, regardless of species, were able to remove about half of the nitrogen dioxide in a small office, five plants removed around 20 percent of the pollutant.
